

Call for emma Doctoral Summer School Grants

The emma Board welcomes applications from PhD candidates and early-stage post-docs (1-2 years from the defense) to attend the bi-annual Doctoral Summer School in 2023 (14-18th August). Dr Päivi Maijanen-Kyläheiko, LUT University, LUT Business School, Lappeenranta, Finland will host the event and you can contact her on email (paivi.maijanen-kylaheiko@lut.fi) for more information.

The Doctoral Summer School provides a supportive and international setting in which doctoral researchers and early-stage post-docs in the field of Media Management can exchange knowledge with peers, senior scholars and industry delegates. By discussing and presenting their research projects at the summer school, participants can further develop their understanding of the respective subject matter, the wider scholarship and practical context of the media industries. The <u>Doctoral Summer School 2018</u> report will provide you with an idea of what you can expect from the experience.

PhD candidates and early-stage post-docs have the opportunity to apply for one of two emma Doctoral Summer School grants of up to €1000 each through which they can financially support their participation. The following elements should be addressed in your application:

- A covering letter explaining the motivation to attend the summer school.
- An endorsement by one of your PhD supervisors
- An academic CV
- Breakdown of costs
- A letter of acceptance from the summer school host
