As part of the pre-conference routine of the European Media Management Association (emma) routine, the organizers (Erasmus University Rotterdam and NHL Stenden) will be hosting a workshop for PhD candidates and very early-career scholars. This workshop will take place on Wednesday, June 5, 2024, at the conference venue. You can participate in the workshop without being registered for the main conference.

Purpose and course of the workshop

The workshop will provide a space for shared learning and reflection about relevant and meaningful aspects of your research and PhD project. We want to give doctoral students the opportunity to present their dissertation projects and receive feedback from peers and senior scholars. In collaborative spirit, we aim for creating and exchange of ideas with each other and with experienced colleagues.

Therefore, the workshop is planned as a "round table" with discussions in small groups (one respondent for two to three doctoral candidates). Professors and postdocs as well as other participants will give feedback in changing constellations and interactive modes, to answer questions raised by the doctoral candidates. The atmosphere aims to be open, creative, inspiring and hopefully lead to fruitful learning.

Participation

Doctoral candidates interested in the workshop are requested to submit an abstract of their dissertation project (max. 3 pages) by April 13th, 2024 via email to both EUR organizers (horst@eshcc.eur.nl & hitters@eshcc.eur.nl). There are no fixed requirements for the layout of the abstract. For the content, however, we would like to see key aspects described and mapped out briefly. These include:

- General topic and the current research question(s)
- Theoretical background and concepts used
- Research methodology (briefly, or keywords)
- Why are you interested in this topic?
- What are the most pressing questions you have?
- What would make this a successful workshop for you?
